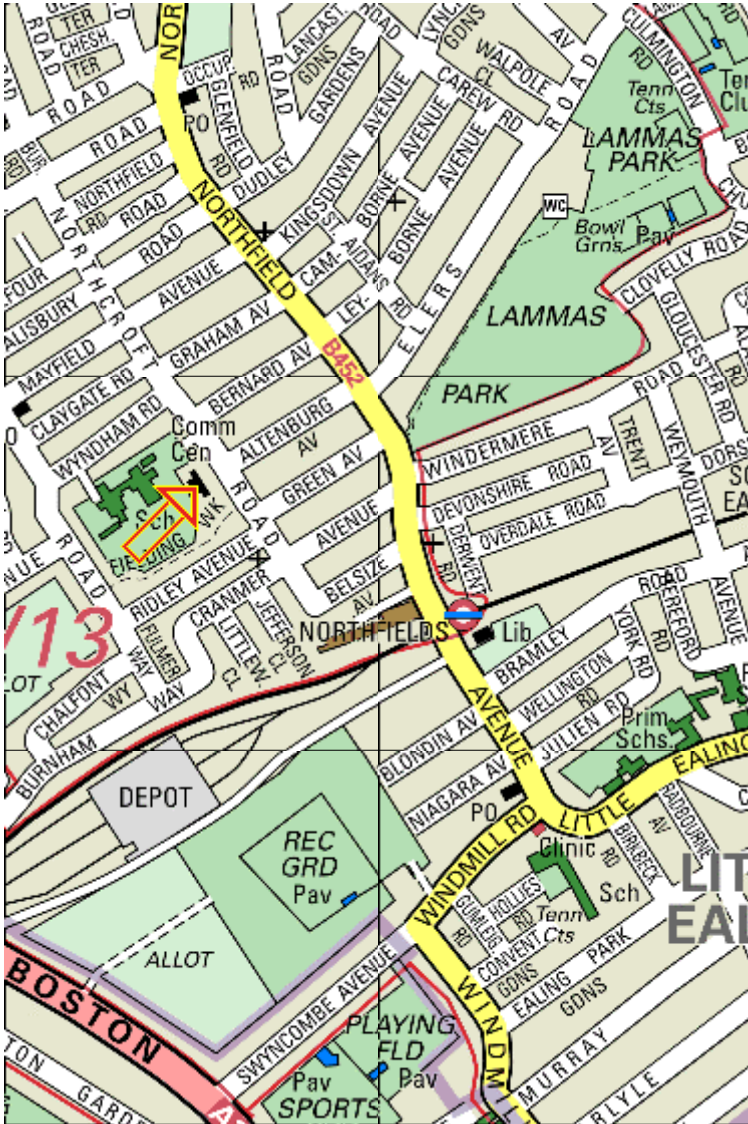


## Map and directions for Shadow Con



### Parking

Only those officially running games or the organisers will have space. Parking restrictions exist on Saturdays (9-10am & 3-4pm). Sundays have no restrictions.

### Nearest Tube

Northfields (Piccadilly Line) is 45 minutes from central London and a 10-minute walk from the centre.

### Nearest Mainline

West Ealing (20 minutes)

### Nearest Buses

E2 (from Ealing Broadway) and E3 (from Greenford) both stop in Northfield Avenue.

### Driving

#### From North/ East

Take the A406 North Circular Road to Ealing Common. Take the A4020 through the centre of Ealing. After a mile turn left into the B452 Northfield Avenue. Altenburg Avenue is about 3/4 of a mile down on the right.

#### From West/South

From the A4 turn north at the roundabout with the B455. After 1/2 mile turn left at the lights into the B4491 Little Ealing Lane. Follow the road past Northfields station and take the 4<sup>th</sup> left into Altenburg Avenue

#### From M25

Take the M4 eastbound. Exit at junction 2 and **IMMEDIATELY** turn left into Lionel Road. Turn left at the lights into the B4491 and then follow the directions above.

### London Underground

Northfields station is on the Heathrow branch of the Piccadilly line and is approximately 45 minutes from central London. Exit the station, cross the road and turn right. Take the 4<sup>th</sup> turning on the left (Altenburg Avenue). The community centre is at the top of the road.

### Mainline Trains & Buses

A local service serves West Ealing station. It is about a mile north of the community centre. From the station head towards the Uxbridge Road and cross over into Northfield Avenue. Carry straight on and Altenburg Avenue is 3/4 mile down on the right. Ealing Broadway station is on the main West Coast line from Paddington. This is about a 30-40 minute walk to the centre but the E2 bus (heading to Brentford) can be picked up directly outside the entrance. The bus journey is about 15 minutes. Get off the bus one stop before Northfields station and you should be one road up from Altenburg Avenue.
