Now our second question you'll remember from last week and comes from Flan and he asks ***"What do you do if you sneeze in your helmet?"***

To answer this we're going to conduct a little experiment and Flan has kindly volunteered to help us. Now if you look through this thick Plexiglas window here you'll see Flan dressed in Stormtrooper armour in that room beyond. We sneezed in Flan helmet just before we went on air and now Flan is going to try and work out what to do. "Ok Flan go for it....." He's taking off the helmet and .....Ohhh look at that his head's exploded.....

So, what do you do when you sneeze in your helmet....thanks to Flan you now know that a good Stormtrooper checks to ensure that they're not in a hostile environment such as vacuum, underwater, or toxic atmosphere. If you are in such an environment then you save that snot as it could be the only thing that you have to eat during extended operations. Gross I know but another example of the uncompromising sacrifices we Stormtroopers are prepared to make for the safety and security of the Empire and its citizens.

To finish off the show we're going to demo another fav Stormtrooper dish - Trout a la boom. This dish couldn't be simpler really.
